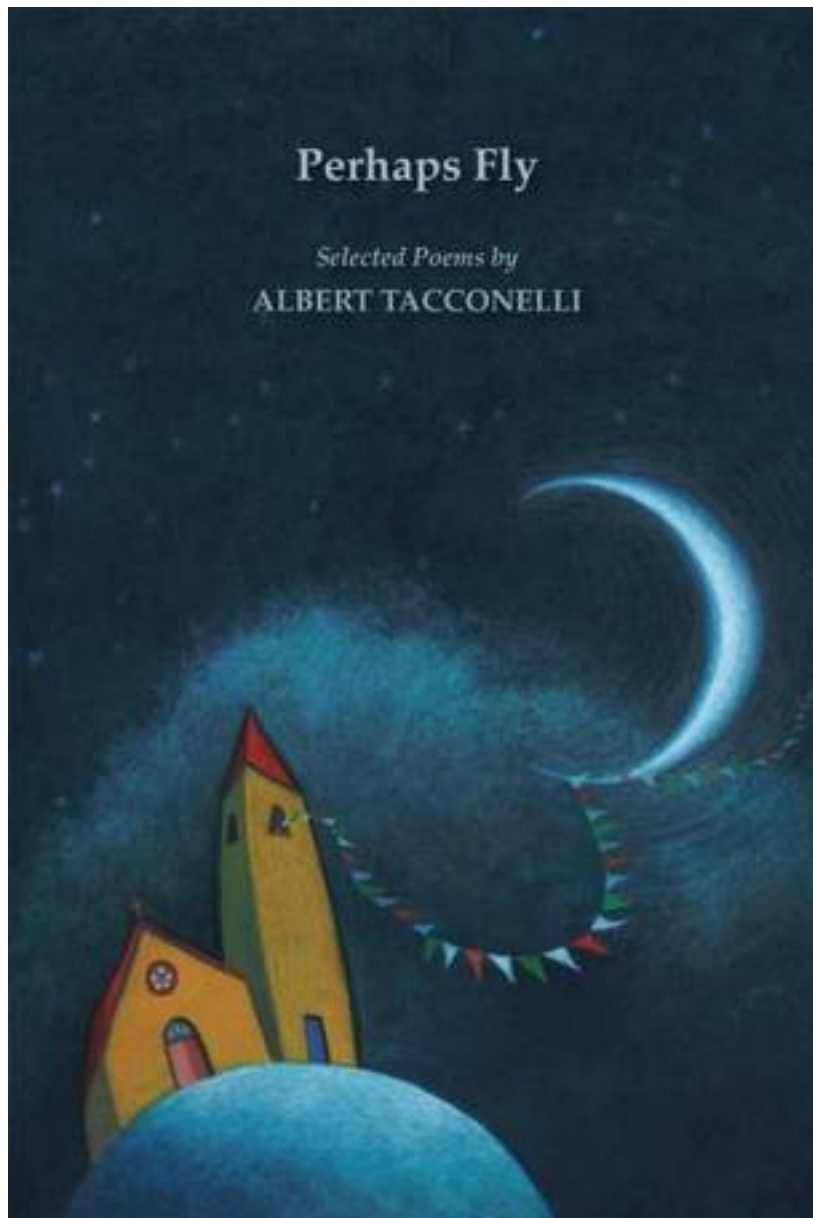




iawa-West presents Amy Barone and Al Taconelli on Saturday, March 14 2015 at Cornelia St. Cafe

Amy Barone's new chapbook, *Kamikaze Dance* ([Finishing Line Press](#) [2]; FLP). She was recognized as a finalist in FLP's New Women's Voices Chapbook Competition. Her poetry has appeared in print and online in [CityLitRag](#) [3], [First Literary Review-East](#) [4], [Gradiva](#) [5], [Impolite Conversation](#) [6], Three Rooms Press' [Maintenant](#), [7] [Philadelphia Poets](#) [8] and [The Rutherford Red Wheelbarrow](#), [9] among others. Her first chapbook, *Views from the Driveway* (Foothills Publishing, 2008). Barone spent five years as a correspondent in Milan for *Women's Wear Daily* and *Advertising Age*. She is a board member of the [Italian American Writers Association](#) [10] (IAWA) and co-curates and promotes IAWA's monthly readings on 2nd Saturdays in New York City. She is a professional member of [PEN America Center](#) [11] and belongs to the [Brevitas](#) [12] online poetry circle. A native of Bryn Mawr, PA, Barone lives in New York City. Artist and poet, Albert Tacconelli's latest poetry collection, *Perhaps Fly* ([Bordighera Press](#) [14]) is preceded by two chapbooks: *Two Countries One Heart*, *The Laurenzi Poems*, *Short Stack*, and *That One Pure Time*. His work has appeared in [Paterson Literary Review](#), [15] *Philadelphia Poets*, *Endicott Review*, [Mad Poets Review](#) [16], VIA, [Avanti Popolo: Italian-Americans Writers Sailing Beyond Columbus](#), [17] and *Fourteenth Poetry Ink Anniversary Anthology*. His artwork is included in the permanent collection of contemporary art at Passaic County Community College; he has exhibited at [The Philadelphia Sketch Club](#), [18] *Mariani Italian American Museum and Institute*, and [Galleria Artemisia](#) [19]. Tacconelli won Honorable Mention in Ohio Poetry Association's Summer Solstice Contest; runner up in Philadelphia Poets First Annual John And Rose Petracca & Family Award; and received the [Allen Ginsberg Poetry Contest](#) [20] Editor's Choice and Honorable Mention. He lives in Wynnewood, Pennsylvania.
